





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### Configuration




Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8" O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8" Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (½ ")



Warning:

The supply valve and supply lines are not included.




#### Important:

Remove the aerator and let both hot and cold water run for one minute. To clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble aerator.


Test system for leaks.

#### **Preparation / Mounting**




- 1. Shut off water supply and drain lines. Clean sink surface thoroughly. Make sure mounting area is clean and dry.
- 2. Remove the plastic locknut (15) and washer (14) from faucet. Don't remove the putty plate (13) from faucet.




3. Position the faucet on the countertop with putty plate (3). Replace the washer (4) and plastic locknuts (5) on the faucet tailpiece (29) and tighten the plastic locknuts (5) by hand.

### Pop-up Installation

Instruction for product with drain option only







- A. Remove pop-up drain stopper (8). and flange (19) with top rubber washer (20) for pop-up assembly.
- B. Insert drain body from underneath of sink drain hole. Replace flange (19) and top rubber washer (20) back to drain body (23). Tighten flange as far as possible.
- C. Slide bottom rubber washer (1) on drain body up against bottom of sink. Tighten locknut (2) firmly against base for tight seal.
- A. Replace pop-up drain stopper (8) to drain body (23) with o-ring in place, and align stopper hole with guide rod opening.

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### Pop-up Installation

Instruction for product with drain option only





- A. Remove rod guide nut 27 and rod ball rubber gasket.
- B. Insert horizontal rod 26 into drain body 23 and through hole in drain stopper (18).
- C. Replace rod guide nut 27 with rod ball rubber gasket and tighten it.
- A. Insert lift rod 4 through hole on faucet body. Connect horizontal rod 6 to extend rod 5 using spring clip 8 to hold and adjust.
- B. Attach extend rod (5) with lift rod (24) by inserting lift rod through extend rod hole. Now adjust lift rod (24) to correct height and hand tighten extend rod screw.
